

Get Involved Through Committees

Committee involvement plays an important role in the success of the BCHBA. Would you or one of your employees be interested in joining a committee? Please mark the boxes of the committees of interest and we will contact you.

Builder/Inspector Task Force - discusses issues relevant to building and inspecting new homes, along with new regulations and UDC codes.

Education - develops the annual education calendar with programs to benefit the membership and discusses volunteer recruitment for local educational events along with fundraising ideas for BCHBA Education Awards.

Fundraising - discusses the oversight and preparation of BCHBA fundraising activities. Committee members seek donations as well as assist with set-up and working of events.

Government Affairs - meets monthly to discuss the state of housing, current political issues, new legislation, how to stimulate investment and growth in the building industry, and how to proactively influence local municipal leaders to keep housing affordable.

Home Expo - provide Home Expo planning and serve as volunteers at the annual Home Expo Event. Members of the committee must be exhibitors in the Home Expo.

Membership Development - Meets monthly to discuss ways to recruit and retain members to the Association, determines programming that would benefit the membership, and contributes to the planning of the BCHBA events calendar. Also responsible for member outreach. They mentor new members for the first few months, and familiarize current members with Association events to encourage participation and member retention.

Multifamily Committee - discusses current issues related to owning and managing multifamily property.

Marketing & Business Development - Learn from an expert in the field about a specific sales, marketing or business development topic during fall and spring monthly sessions.

Showcase - responsible for reviewing Showcase Guidelines and planning for the Spring & Fall Showcase Events.

Associate Member:
Any person, firm or corporation engaged in a trade, industry or profession related to shelter construction, remodeling or land development, and not inconsistent with the objectives of the Brown County Home Builders Association (BCHBA) and is of good character and good business reputation, shall be eligible.

OR

Builder Member:
Any person, firm, or corporation currently in the business of shelter construction, land development, or remodeling; and agrees to subscribe to the Code of Ethics and Bylaws of this Association; and is of good character and business reputation; and has successfully completed the required education programs as described in the BCHBA's Policy and Procedure manual for builder members as designated by the BCHBA Board of Directors, shall be eligible to be a Builder member.

This person, firm, or corporation must have successfully completed and filed with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (DSPS) a Business Credential Application and have been granted a Dwelling Contractor Certification (DCC). In addition, they must complete and file a Wisconsin DSPS Credential Application and be granted a Dwelling Contractor Qualifier Certification (DCQ). Also, according to the Wisconsin DSPS, a builder must renew his DCQ and is contingent upon the builder qualifier obtaining at least 12 hours of acceptable continuing education three months prior to the expiration date of their credential, which is two years after the start date of the credential. If at any time the DCQ and/or DCC become invalid that Builders membership will be transferred to an Associate membership until such time that the DCQ and/or DCC are deemed valid by the Wisconsin DSPS and verified by the BCHBA.

To be eligible to participate in the Spring or Fall Showcase of Homes a member must be an approved Builder member prior to the final deadline to withdraw an entry and have held a membership in the BCHBA for a minimum of one (1) year prior to the event.
