HOW WOULD YOU LIKE THE OPPORTUNITY TO SPEND YOUR MONEY TWICE?

You can, at our Auction scheduled for **Thursday, April 11, 2024** at the Swan Club in De Pere! This is the chance to purchase an item and put the money aside and then gift it to the candidate of your choice during any election period. The money may only be given to state and local candidates. Federal candidates cannot receive money from these funds.

The process is very simple: If you win the bid on the auction item, you pay for that item. At the same time, you have an option to direct your contribution to either the BBW fund or your BDF fund. Wisconsin Builders Association (WBA) will transfer the money into the account you specify. Now, isn't that fun, spending your money twice, and for a good cause?!

What is the BBW fund?

It is WBA members from across the state combining their resources to support pro-housing, pro-business candidates running for office in Wisconsin. Our local association is allowed one Trustee on the Committee, comprised of other Trustees from state HBAs. This Committee determines which candidates receive contributions and provides collective statewide support of our legislative priorities.

What is the BDF fund?

It allows those who actively give to candidates running for state or local office an opportunity to give through their local and state association, which helps to reach the fundraising goal for that year. WBA and your association receive recognition from the candidate and you still receive credit for your personal contribution! A minimum contribution of \$100 is required.

After winning the bid, how do I pay for the items?

Whether you direct your contribution to the BBW or BDF accounts, only personal contributions may be accepted, unless a company is a single member LLC; no corporate checks or corporate credit cards are allowed. Personal checks and or personal VISA or MasterCard and PAC Bucks for any amount are welcome.

Is the auction accepting donations?

Absolutely, and we need your help! If you are able to donate any items or make a cash donation, we appreciate it! Examples of donations include Packers items, sporting goods, dinner gift certificates, getaway packages, tools, electronics, home decor and gift baskets. All cash donations will be pooled to purchase additional items to auction. A member of the Fundraising Committee may be contacting you soon to ask if you are willing and able to donate. Donations to the PAC cannot be used as a charitable contribution for federal income tax purposes.
