2024 Backyard Getaway Contest

Win \$250+ cash for your school by entering the Backyard Getaway Contest! We are asking students to build a project that creates a backyard getaway for the whole family! A backyard getaway is a place to enjoy your outdoor space. <u>BE CREATIVE!</u> Your projects will be seen by *THOUSANDS* of consumers attend the Green Bay Home + Lifestyles Experience held on February 9-11, 2024, at the Resch Expo. Attendees will have the opportunity to vote for their favorite and even place bids to make the Backyard Getaway Project the newest addition to their home. Bids may be placed online with each project going to its highest bidder. Bid winners will be responsible to pick up their Backyard Getaway Project at completion of the contest. Proceeds from the sale of the Backyard Getaway Projects will support the Brown County Home Builders Association Educational Programs.

PARTICIPATION CRITERIA

- The Backyard Getaway Contest is to be designed and built by middle school students, with teacher supervision, in the school districts within the counties of Brown, Kewaunee, Marinette, and eastern Oconto counties.
- 1 team, 1 Project entry per school: no limit on the number of students working on school's entry.
- The Backyard Getaway Project should be functional, useable, transportable, and able to be lifted by no more than 3 persons; no larger than 4'W x 5'L x 5'H and fit easily on a 4' x 5' pallet with no overhang. All entries must be delivered on wheels to ensure easy mobility for set up. (Please email pparish@bchba.org for size questions and exception requests).
- Materials used should be reasonable, cost effective, and creative.
- Backyard Getaway Projects must include at least one component of recycled material.
- The BCHBA will work with each school to solicit BCHBA members to sponsor supplies for your project.
- The BCHBA will, if requested, supply the school with a mentor to help with the project.
- Schools must provide a series of at least five (5) photos taken during planning and construction. The BCHBA will post photographs and promote this contest in its advertising, on its website and on the BCHBA Facebook Page.
- Completion of project by January 31, 2024, with the final photo emailed to the BCHBA by noon.
- The school assumes responsibility to transport project to contest location on February 8, 2024.
- Entries will be judged on construction design, functionality, creativity, and use of recycled materials.
- Cash Awards will be given to the school for the People's Choice and Builders Awards; contest winners will be notified after the Home + Lifestyles Experience is completed.
- Participating schools are also qualified for our Tools for Schools Program, sponsored by The Power Tool Store. Schools must provide an equipment wish list to be fulfilled at the beginning of the contest.
