BUILDING FUTURES EDUCATION AWARD

The Roger and Cathy Gryboski Building Futures Education Award honors the shared legacy of Roger and Cathy Gryboski, who together built a homebuilding business rooted in service and integrity. Roger was a proud member and past president of the Brown County Home Builders Association (BCHBA), where he made lasting contributions to the organization and its mission. Cathy shared that same commitment to leadership and service as the inaugural president of the BCHBA Women’s Auxiliary, helping to establish a culture of involvement and community support. Together, Roger and Cathy were known for their dedication to quality, professionalism, and ethical leadership in the building trades. They valued the relationships they built with employees, subcontractors, and customers, many of whom became lifelong friends. This scholarship was established to support students pursuing careers in the building trades or related fields, continuing their shared legacy of craftsmanship, mentorship, and community building.

A \$1,500 award will be granted to a graduating high school senior pursuing a degree directly related to the home building industry.

ELIGIBILITY

- Reside in Brown, Kewaunee, Marinette or Eastern Oconto County
- Be a graduating high school senior at the time of application
- Pursue post-secondary education in a field related to the home building industry (e.g., construction management, architecture, engineering, skilled trades, interior design, etc.)

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Completed application form
- Letter of recommendation from a teacher
- Personal statement explaining why the student chose to pursue a career in the home building industry

AWARD DISTRIBUTION

- Recipient will be selected by Gryboski Builders, Inc.
- Award will be distributed after the completion of the student’s first semester of post-high school education
- To receive the award, the student must submit:
 - Proof of enrollment in the second semester
 - Official transcript showing a GPA of 2.5 or higher
 - Check will be issued directly to the recipient’s school upon verification
